Current Needs

Vehicles

Vehicles can be donated to MCYC for a write off on your taxes, please check with your tax professional for information.

Pick-up Truck – 4x4, automatic, gently used, operational, and in good mechanical condition.

Mid-sized/compact car – automatic, FWD, gently used, operational, able to get 25 – 30 MPG. We currently use our camp van or truck to visit homes and churches, this past year we visited 14 churches!! By getting a small car this can save us up to \$2,000 per year in fuel with better mileage.

ATV Vehicle – gently used and in good operational condition, 4wd, automatic would be amazing.

Snow Plow Blade – We plow all the snow at MCYC on our tractor. The tractor is open to the elements and this can be pretty tough while outside in a Michigan winter for hours at a time.

Materials

We go through a lot of materials each year. These are easy items to help us with a small donation.

Riding Helmets – Each camper wears a helmet to ride a horse. Cost is \$40 per helmet at Tractor Supply Company (TSC) or you could mail us a gift card for TSC to purchase.

Extension Cords – 50 or 100ft, outdoor. Usually about \$30 - \$100 per cord.

Roofing Nail Gun – 1 – Cost is about \$200 for a name brand at Home Depot. A gift card would work great for Home Depot for us to go purchase as we get nice discounts at Home Depot to make the dollars go farther!

Toilets – Yep, we could always use a new toilet. MCYC currently has 54 toilets. So just imagine how many we may go through in a year!! Cost at Home Depot is \$150.

Gift Cards

Gas Gift Cards - \$50 amounts. Wal-Mart works best as it is closest to camp, Sunoco is our main gas station near camp besides Wal-Mart

Gift Cards to Office Depot, Amazon.com, Tractor Supply Company, Wal-Mart, and Home Depot. Increments of \$25/\$50 or more will do great works! These go to purchase miscellaneous supplies for summer camp and general operations of the camp throughout the year.

Capital Investment Items

These are items that your donations go towards when you check 'capital fund' on your envelope.

Boiler for the Lodge – We are in need of a new boiler to heat our lodge. Our current boiler is 33 years old and in need of replacement. Estimated financial impact is \$15,000 to replace it. We have already gotten a company to agree to put in the new boiler for no cost!

3-Compartment Stainless Steel Sink – Needed to replace our current sink that is wood and aging. This can be new or used. Estimated financial need to replace is \$500 (used) to \$2,500 (new).

Computers – We are in need of five new computers. Our 'youngest' computer is 5 years old and our oldest is 11 years old. Estimated financial need is \$6,000 to replace all five.

Counter Tops – Our counter tops in the bathrooms in the lodge and in our dorms are in need of replacement. Estimated replacement is \$400 and \$850 each. We are in need of two for the lodge and 13 for our dorm rooms.
